Wayside Waifs Transfers in 38 Dogs and Puppies

KANSAS CITY, Missouri – Wayside Waifs was contacted by the ASPCA® (The American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals®) to take in a transfer of 38 dogs and puppies. The ASPCA Animal Relocation team transported the dogs from Hobbs, NM to a local airport. **The animals will arrive at Wayside on Tuesday, January 18, at approximately 1 pm.**

Most of the dogs are smaller breeds including Chihuahuas, Min Pins, and mixes. The majority are adult dogs but there are some puppies. As of now, Wayside doesn't know the exact medical status of the animals, our vet team will examine them after they've arrived at Wayside to find out.

Please note, the puppies and dogs on this transfer won't be made available for adoption until they are medically and behaviorally evaluated, have been spayed or neutered, are up-to-date on vaccinations, and have a microchip.
