We accomplish our mission by protecting and caring for the animals under our watch; by reaching out to the community for love and support; and by teaching others about the profound joy that pets bring to our lives.

Together We Save Animals How You Can Get Involved

Wayside Waifs is preparing pets and people for the bond of their lives. On a 50 acre campus, we care for 6,200 abandoned, abused, and neglected animals every year. We rescue animals locally and nationally by working with nearby Animal Controls, more than 65 regional shelter partners, national rescue organizations, and by deploying our Animal Rescue and Response Team. We deliver comprehensive life-saving medical care and transformational behavioral assessments to homeless animals while in our care. Once the animals are ready for adoption, we help them find new, loving homes because all animals deserve a second chance. We are a leader in educating the community about animal welfare issues. Our Humane Educators and companion animals teach students our No More Bullying! curriculum, Activating Em-PAW-thy, Dog Safety, Reading for People and Pets, and more. And we provide compassionate end of life care to family pets through our Pet Memorial Services.

We are able to do all of these things because of you! Your support, in whatever way you're able to provide, saves lives! Here are a few ways you can get involved:

Adopt: We have the furry family member missing from your life! The animals in our care include dogs, puppies, cats, kittens, and small mammals. 
Donate: We don't receive any government funding but rely solely on the support from generous donors. Donations can be made in many ways – by individuals, corporations, or even youth who donate profits from their lemonade stand. Be creative! These donations provide life-saving medical care, comprehensive behavioral care, nutritious food, warm beds, and constant love until the animals find forever homes.

Volunteer: There are many ways you can volunteer at Wayside - cat socializing, dog walking, humane education, event support, vet clinic assistance, meet & greet specialist, and more! Visit WaysideWaifs.org for more info.

Foster: One specialized, and very important role, is that of Foster Volunteer. These individuals welcome homeless animals into their homes – some recovering from surgery, others too young to be adopted. Wayside provides everything the animal needs during their stay with you including food, medical care (including medicine & vet visits), blankets, toys, etc.

Feline-ality A Personality Test for Cats



Looking for a cat who will be by your side a lot? Adopt a Personal Assistant. Or would you rather have a cat who likes to warm up to you before showering you with affection? Then you need a Secret Admirer.

At Wayside we work with our cats to determine their personalities. We've adopted the Feline-ality test, originally created by the ASPCA and used at shelters nationwide, as a way to fully understand the cat's personality in new environments. The assessment predicts how a cat is likely to behave in their new home.

In addition to assessing the cats, we learn about potential adopters. We have them complete an Adopter Survey which tells us their preferences and expectations. We then are able to have conversations with them, including open ended questions, to talk freely about what they want versus what a specific cat may provide them. We can help them find a cat that fits their needs and wants.

In the end, we know that this assessment allows us to better place cats in their forever homes with humans. We hear adopters praise the assessment and how it helped them find the perfect cat.

There are 9 feline personality types:

- Executive: this cat is always doing something playing with a toy, looking out the window and they like to include time during their day to socialize with you.
- Leader of the Band: this cat is adventurous and likes to have everyone follow their lead. They have a lot of confidence but also show you affection.
- Love Bug: this cat is 100% affection ... loves petting, purrs, and paws kneading your lap. They like quality time to spend with you.
- MVP (Most Valuable Pussycat): this cat likes space but also wants to be with you. Just imagine the cat who wants to sit on the couch by your side ... maybe even have their ears scratched.
- Party Animal: this cat is always up to party with you, with others, or by themselves! They like to play with toys, liven up parties, and make everyone laugh.
- Personal Assistant: this cat is stuck to you like glue ... helping you cook, clean, and relax. They want to be your best friend who's always in your life.
- Private Investigator: this cat knows how to keep your secrets.
 They know how to stay out of trouble. And they know how to keep an eye out on you and your home.
- Secret Admirer: this is a smart cat. Logical up front knows what they're doing and completely lovable later, sharing lap time and purrs once you're best buds.
- **Sidekick:** this cat is a reliable and steady companion. They like a little bit of everything good in life attention as well as solitude. They're all-around great company.
