

The Fenby Webster Medical Fund You Provide Critical Care

We believe all animals deserve medical treatment – whether they arrive to our shelter with recent traumatic injuries or come to us with a chronic illness. Our commitment to providing compassionate, life-saving medical care to the shelter animals prompted us to create The Fenby Webster Medical Care Fund.

The Fenby Fund directly supports the medical care of Wayside's most sick and injured shelter animals — providing care above and beyond traditional animal care of spay/neuter, vaccinations, and flea/tick control. The Fenby Fund underwrites the cost of treatment for Heartworm disease and other upper respiratory infections, life-saving surgeries (both that Wayside's veterinary team perform as well as those done through our veterinary specialist partners), diagnostic testing, dentistry (including dental extractions), and so much more.

Meet two animals who received life-saving care from The Fenby Fund:

Ms. V, a 1 year old cat, came to Wayside as a stray with torn skin down both sides of her body. It looked like she injured herself while going under a barbed wire fence. Dr. Kelly, Wayside's Chief of Veterinary Medicine, performed emergency surgery on her and reattached her skin with 87 staples. Now she's healing in a foster home while receiving the comfort and love she deserves.

Baby Jane, a 7 year old dog, was leaking urine at the shelter. After running tests, we determined she may be incontinent. Unfortunately, incontinence is extremely hard to diagnose in shelter environments. Sadly, animals are sometimes euthanized due to the chronic illness. But because of you, she was able to be fostered while finding a medication that helps her. She's since been adopted into a loving family.

These two homeless animals, along with thousands of others, are cared for every year at Wayside. Thanks to you and The Fenby Fund, we're able to care for our most sick and injured animals. We're very grateful to everyone who donates to The Fenby Fund to ensure the animals get the care they deserve.

Brody Succeeds At Life Thanks To Your Support

Brody was scared, confused, and alone. At only one year old, all he had known during his short life was living in a shelter.

Brody had been transferred to Wayside because the shelter where he was living had run out of space and could no longer care for him. Upon arrival, our medical team examined him and discovered he had Heartworms – a potentially deadly disease when left untreated.

We are very thankful that, because of you, Wayside could treat the Heartworms and save Brody's life. But it was hard seeing Brody in the shelter every day. He was friendly, and had lots of energy. Everyone saw his infectious personality but knew he couldn't share it due to his medical restrictions while being treated for Heartworms. Volunteers and staff enjoyed spending time with him but hated seeing him have to return to his temporary home inside a kennel.

That lasted for eight months. Eight long months.

Then one day, Wayside staff member, Amy Putman, made everyone's dreams come true – she adopted Brody with her boyfriend and their dog, Dany. As a former Canine Care Technician, her job was to care for the dogs at Wayside, and she fell in love with Brody during that process. She knew he had received a wonderful level of medical care, the best behavior care, and an abundant amount of love during his time at the shelter. She had seen it with her own eyes! She knew based off of her own interactions with Brody, that he was a wonderful dog who needed a loving home.

"Brody was the missing piece to our family; now we're whole." said Amy.

Since his adoption, Brody has continued to grow into his own.

Recently he graduated from Wayside's Public Training Class. He successfully learned commands like sit, leave it, and come in the Basic Obedience Class. These skills are great for Brody — they help him in his day-to-day interactions with his humans, his dog sister, while on walks, and while he visits Wayside when his mom takes him to work. In addition to preparing him for life in a home, the class provided guidance for problem solving basic behaviors such as jumping up and potty training.

Another way that we've seen Brody shine since being adopted is by joining his mom in Wayside's Humane Education department. Amy, a former school teacher, was promoted to a Humane Educator. She goes into classrooms of grade school students and teaches our No More Bullying! program.



The program consists of five, one-hour days that teach kids about compassion, empathy, and being humane. A special element of the program is that educators have a companion animal by their side teaching the curriculum. And we're happy to say that Brody joins his mom as her Companion Animal to spread kindness to children in Kansas City!

Brody may have been homeless, but he's now living his best life with his forever family. Thanks to you, he's overcome many obstacles. He learned many commands in his Dog Training class and is now teaching kids in the community how to be kinder to one another. Thank you for saving Brody and other homeless animals like him. None of this could happen without you!
